

### Resource Six: Self Assessment of Writing

7. What did you find to be the most challenging aspect of this assignment?
8. Did you use a writing center or have anyone critique your paper and was this helpful?
9. How many drafts were completed before the final draft was turned in?
10. How would you do things differently for the next writing assignment?
